

Certificate in Network Administration

Requirements

Eligibility

Applicants for the certificate will need to meet one of the following criteria:

- 1. Have a bachelor's degree in any field from an accredited institution or
- 2. Have an associate of arts degree from a two-year accredited college and a minimum of two years of business experience **or**
- 3. Have a major in business at an accredited four-year institution of higher education.

Note: Students majoring in IS (or an equivalent program) are not eligible for the BAI or NA Certificates.

Prerequisites

Before entering the certificate program, applicants will need to demonstrate that they:

- 1. Have completed at least six units of elementary accounting
- 2. Are conversant in computer concepts (equivalent to IS 52 and 52L at a minimum.)
- 3. Have filled out the application form and sent it to csbstusupport@mail.fresnostate.edu

Approval of the certificate program coordinator or the department chair is required.
