

Dear Students,

Thanks to the generous support of President Castro and donors in the community, there is a grant available for students participating in international service-learning study. This grant is intended for students who need financial support for their trip and generally has a limit of \$500/student. In extreme situations of financial hardship, \$1,000/student may be awarded.

In order to apply for these funds, please submit a response to the following two questions. Limit the response to each question to 200 words or less.

Question 1: Describe current financial support that you are receiving to attend Fresno State (student loans, scholarships, grants, other financial aid, parental support, etc.), and describe how those funds do not meet the cost associated with your planned international service-learning course.

Question 2: Describe any specific or unique financial burdens that you are currently facing. This could involve supporting family members, outstanding loans, being financially independent from parents, insurance costs, or other reasons that you are in need of this grant.

Funds awarded will be used to cover transportation costs, program fees, or course enrollment fees. Any amount awarded will be paid directly to the vendor (i.e., travel agent, Madventurer, or CGE), unless otherwise approved by Continuing & Global Education (CGE), in advance.
