Femininity and Dominance Across the Lifespan:

Longitudinal Findings from Two Cohorts of Women

Dr. Constance Jones, from the Department of Psychology at Fresno State, will summarize results from her study of original women participants, and daughters of original participants, of the Intergenerational Studies, a set of studies begun in Berkeley and Oakland in 1929. Two aspects of personality - femininity and dominance - show both interesting cohort differences and developmental change in these samples.
