

# My Degree Plan

**What it is:** Interactive course planning tool used to plan courses for future semesters. It is linked with the DPR and allows students to plan efficiently towards graduation.

**How it helps:** The University plans to use the data from My Degree Plan (MDP) to ensure there are enough seats in courses to meet the demand of students planning to take them.
