



Course Requirements for Minor in Viticulture

VIT 101 General Viticulture I (3) and

VIT 102 General Viticulture II (3)

8 units of Viticulture Electives Including:

VIT 106 Wine Grape Production (2) or both

VIT 103 Raising Production and Processing (2) and

VIT 105 Production and Marketing of Table Grapes (2)

VIT 160 Mechanized Viticulture (3) or

VIT 165 Grape Varieties and Rootstocks (2)

Any of the following:

BIOL 161 Plant Physiology (4)

VIT 162T Topics in Viticulture (1-4)

VIT 190 Independent Study (1-3)

VIT 194 Grape and Wine Industry Internship (2-4)

VIT 199 Viticulture Seminar (1)

This gives the minor a minimum of 14 units of coursework, all of which are upper-division. Though not listed, students will need to complete 10-16 units of prerequisite coursework depending on the electives the student selects and their prior experience. In many cases, these courses will be required as part of their majors.
