How to schedule an appointment: Call or walk in to our office (AG 110).

“No show” policy: Students with three “no shows” on their record forfeit the right to schedule appointments for the remainder of the semester and are only eligible to attend walk-in hours.

Walk-ins: Every Wednesday from 9am-11am, and 1:30pm-4pm.

Appointments must be canceled at least 30 minutes before scheduled time, and must be made at least 24 hours in advance.

Students should arrive early for their appointment with their student ID card, and must be prepared with relevant documents and/or questions.

Students who arrive more than 10 minutes late to their appointment will be marked as a “no show” and asked to reschedule.
