The employer pre-registration fee is affordable. **Only \$75.00 payable to Fresno State** includes refreshments, lunch, and a courtesy parking pass for two representatives. Additional reps will be charged an additional \$10 per person. Registration fees also help offset career fair expenses including rentals and supplies.
