### **MATCHING CHALLENGE UPDATE**

#### **Fresno State Viticulture and Enology Alumni Association Raise \$92,330 through Matching Challenge Campaign**

The Fresno State Viticulture and Enology Alumni Association is pleased to announce that it has raised **\$92,330** dollars in response to the \$40,000 matching challenge posed by Dr. Robert Wample, Chair Emeritus of the Department of Viticulture and Enology, and his wife, Pam Wample, in 2014. In addition to the \$40,000 match from the Wample's, the Viticulture and Enology Alumni Association received \$53,330 from private and company donors.

Funds raised from the matching challenge will be used to support the V.E. Petrucci Library, located in the Department of Viticulture and Enology. The only stand-alone viticulture and enology library in the United States, the Petrucci Library serves the students, faculty, and staff of the Department and the University, as well as the grape, wine, and raisin industries. Supported by an endowment founded by the VEAA in 1996, the V.E. Petrucci Library will be celebrating its 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary next year.

Dr. James Kennedy, Chair of the Department of Viticulture and Enology, says he can't thank the VEAA and donors enough. "The Petrucci Library is an essential element of our academic and research programs, and the library services provided to our grape and wine colleagues are some of many the Department is proud to offer our industry."

Jon Holmquist, Treasurer for the VEAA, is also grateful to the many donors of the campaign. "I'm particularly excited by the donations from students. Their vocal support and hard work are great to see!" Holmquist said. "The time and dollars they've given to this campaign shows how much students value the library, and the VEAA is pleased to continue to support and work with students for this cause."
