

Wrath Wines--Cellar/Assistant Winemaker

Wrath Wines in Soledad California is looking to fill a full-time position. We are a very small winery and the candidate will be responsible to learn how to run a facility from snout to tail. The ideal candidate will be open minded, self-starter and eager to learn. The person will be responsible for mastering the duties of the cellar before moving onto the more developed position of Assistant Winemaker.

We are looking for someone who fits in with our small team and is willing to grow with the company to produce highly regarded Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Syrah and Sauvignon Blanc from the Monterey and SLH AVA's. We also do a lot of experiments, so this person needs to think outside the box.

We do not expect the candidate to know how to do all of the following, but rather learn and grow into understanding the winery and the requirements of the wine. Responsibilities of the positions are as follows:

- Manage the cellar:
 - Cleaning protocols for all equipment that includes: tanks, pumps, filter, press, sorting table, hopper, and anything that wine touches.
 - Barrel Management
 - Equipment Repair and basic understanding of glycol system and facility.
 - Barrel Line Operations: we own and operate our own bottling line and the candidate will learn to run the line and maintain the line.
 - Be able to lift 50 pounds
- Lab:
 - Understand and be able to run all basic analysis we use to manage the wines.
 - Maintain and clean lab equipment.
 - Maintain a lab book.
- Office:
 - Learn basic compliance.
 - Work with office administrator on inventory, ordering, and processing of ordered items.
 - Budgeting
- Other:
 - Since we are a small winery we are “all hands on deck”. The candidate needs to appreciate that aspect of our operation. We all pitch in when needed even if it is not in your “job description”.
 - Bachelors or Master's Degree in Viticulture and Enology or related field.
 - Spanish a plus+.
