

Starmont Vineyards are looking for a harvest intern for a vineyard internship and transition into the cellar at Starmont.

Job responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

Vineyard Duties:

- Monitoring vine stress
- Pest scouting
- Berry sampling for maturation
- Crop survey and estimations
- Data entry and tracking
- Harvest quality monitoring
- Vineyard data collection

Cellar Duties:

- Execute the following types of work orders while assisting Cellar Worker 2 or being directly supervised by Cellar Master or Cellar Worker 3
 - Barrel Racking – Bulldog or pump
 - Any Tank or Barrel Addition
 - Barrel filling from tank
 - Barrel and tank topping
 - Tank racking
- Maintain a clean environment in a professional manner
 - Sanitize equipment prior to use / rinse and put away equipment after use
 - Ensure bungs / barrels are clean prior to restacking
 - Ensure dirty bungs are cleaned and properly stored in a timely manner
 - Rinse floors after completing work, scrub with cleaning products if necessary
- Maintain a safe work environment in a professional manner
 - Follow all safety protocols as communicated in IIPP and monthly safety meetings
 - Always wear appropriate clothing for any given task
- Maintain equipment with a professional standard
 - Label broken / malfunctioning equipment and alert Cellar Master
 - Treat all equipment and tools with care and always return it to its proper place of storage
 - Alert Cellar Master if any tools or equipment are worn out and in need of replacement

Time would roughly be split 70% Vineyard 30% Cellar

Required:

Must have valid driver's license and reliable transportation (4WD preferred)

Must be flexible with schedule, required to work early mornings and weekends, overtime required

Spanish helpful

Must be able to lift 50lbs and walk long distances

Position is full-time temporary, from approximately 4/1/2014 to 11/30/14
