Interns will primarily assist vineyard managers with phenological data collection, vineyard work, and other special projects. The internship will run from May 23th – August 22nd. There is a possibility of extending the internship through harvest, assuming both worker and employer wish to continue the internship. Hourly rate is dependent on experience.

Job duties could include:

- Collection of soil, tissue, and fruit samples
- Collection of data to help estimate crop loads
- Aid in the distribution and collection of Vine Mealy Bug traps
- Assist in the coordination and execution of the maturation monitoring program
- Work with field crews on various viticulture activities: crop thinning, leafing, etc.
- Input field scouting and phenological data into MS Excel and a farm management database

- Ability to work 5 days a week for 8-10 consecutive hours outdoors
- Ability to report to work in early morning hours
