The Harvest Enology Intern is responsible for running the majority of the laboratory analysis, entering data, and communicating all information to Winemaker/Assistant Winemaker in a thorough and timely manner. In addition, daily tasks will include fermentation checks and additions, as well as vineyard sampling & cellar work as needed.

Applicants must be able to lift 50lbs, have reliable housing and transportation, and be at least 21 years of age.
