

Reviewing the CI 171 Marzano Lessons (April 12)

Can you recognize each of the Direct Instruction lesson's six (6) basic parts:

1. State the learning objective (A-B-C-D) and orient students to the lesson (What will students know or be able to do after the lesson?. What will be the outcome of their learning? How will you know when and how well students have achieved these learning outcomes or objectives?). IN THIS PART YOU WILL ORIENT STUDENTS TO WHAT'S COMING UP, WHY WHAT YOU'RE GOING TO HELP THEM UNDERSTAND IS IMPORTANT, HOW THEY WILL BE EXPECTED TO LISTEN AND ENGAGE. IN THIS PART OF THE LESSON YOU WILL TALK WITH THE GROUP TO EXPLAIN WHY WHAT THEY'RE ABOUT TO EXPERIENCE IS IMPORTANT.
2. Review prerequisites (What prerequisite skills are needed to learn this content?)
3. Present new material (What information/experiences will YOU provide to help students acquire the knowledge and skills they need in order to attain the learning outcomes?).
4. Conduct learning probes (ASK QUESTIONS OF THE GROUP: DO YOU UNDERSTAND WHAT YOU'VE JUST HEARD?).
5. Provide independent practice (What methods of teaching will you incorporate?).
6. Assess performance and provide feedback.
