Credential courses are taken in sequenced phases and must be completed at an acceptable level in order to move on. Any grade listed as "I", "D", or "F" is unacceptable. You must also maintain a 3.0 GPA in all credential program courses with no individual course grade lower than a "C".

Prior to phase 3, you need to qualify for field placement in Field Study C: Final Student Teaching, which occurs in the final semester of the credential program. To achieve this, you must accomplish the following:

- ✓ Maintain a **3.00 GPA** in all credential courses with no individual grade lower than a "C".
- ✓ Complete the **Field Placement Form** and turn in to ED 100 the semester prior to when you plan to do your final student teaching.
- ✓ Successfully pass all sections of the **CBEST**.
- ✓ Successfully pass all sections of the **CSET**.

The faculty and staff are looking forward to working with you as a teacher candidate and hope you will gain knowledge and experience that will stay with you through your teaching career.
