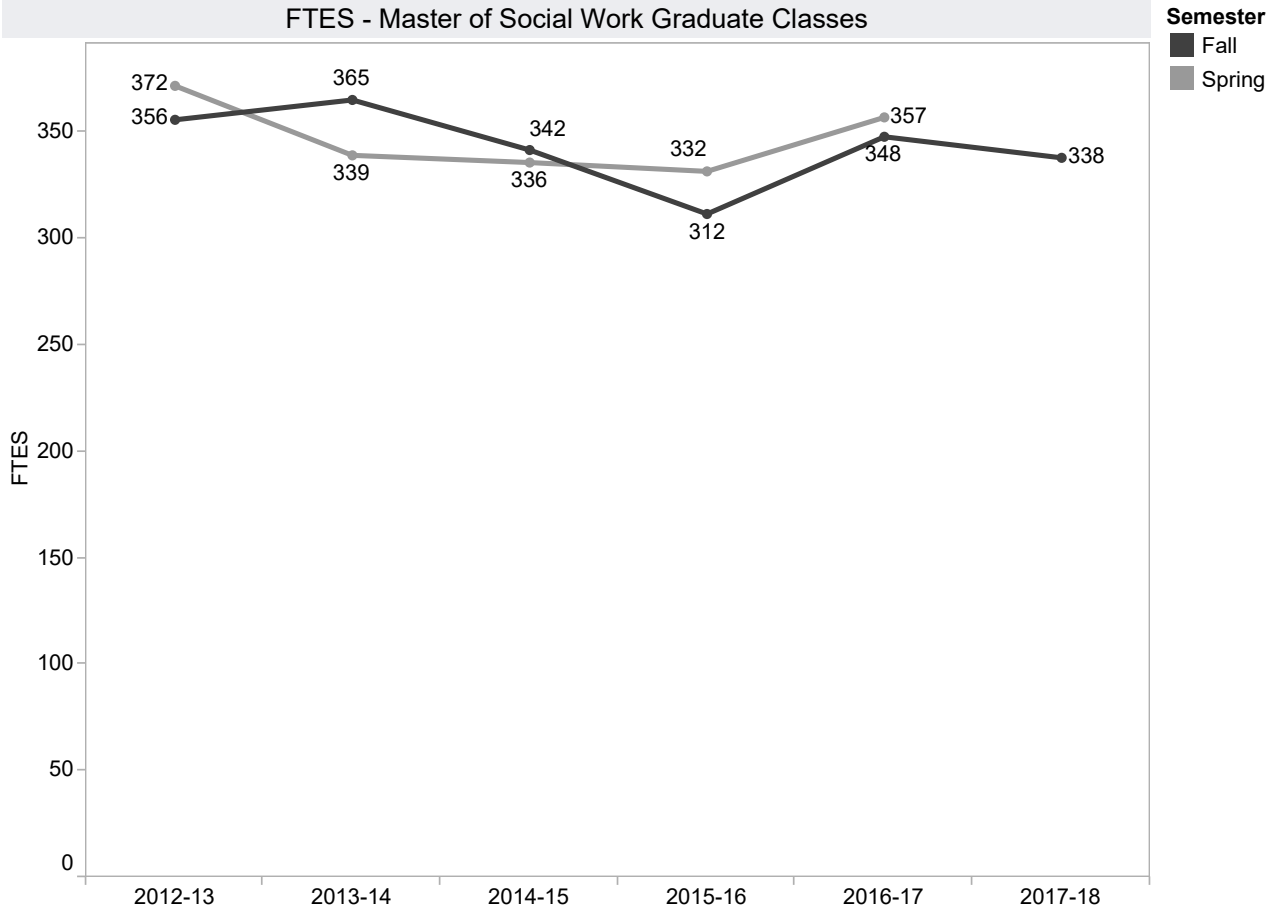


Enrollment by Program, College and University Fall 2012 - Fall 2017



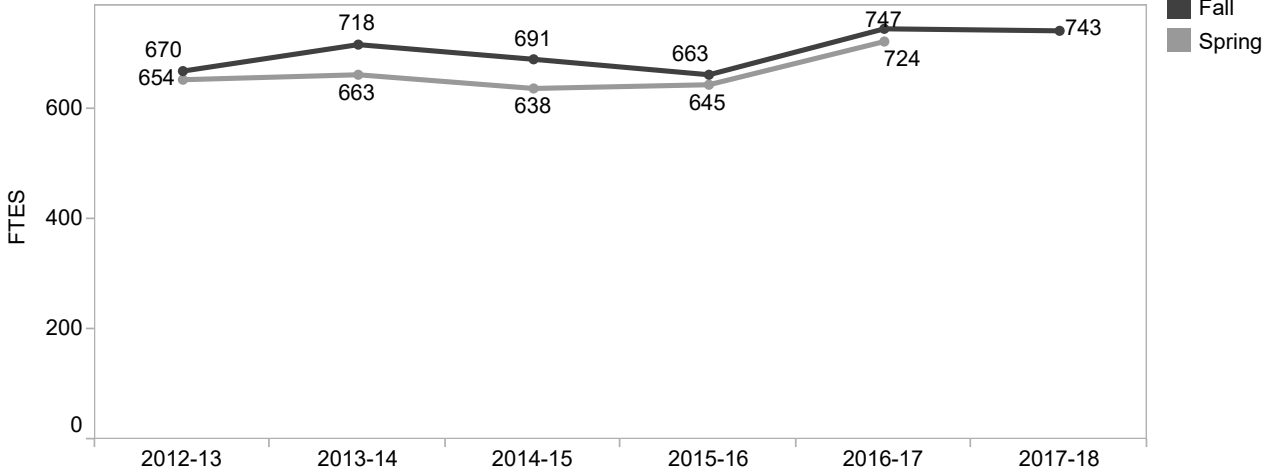

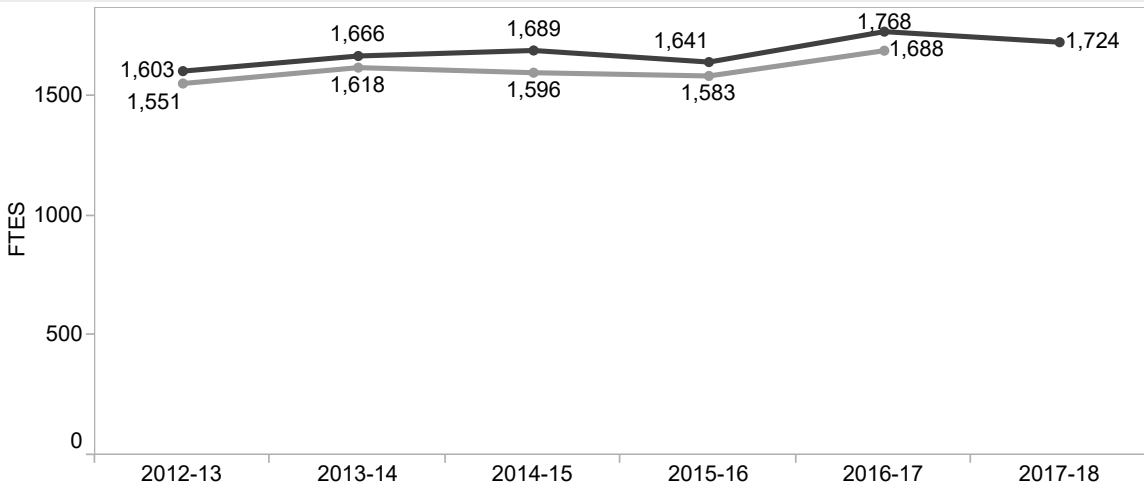

Graduate Classes FTES - University



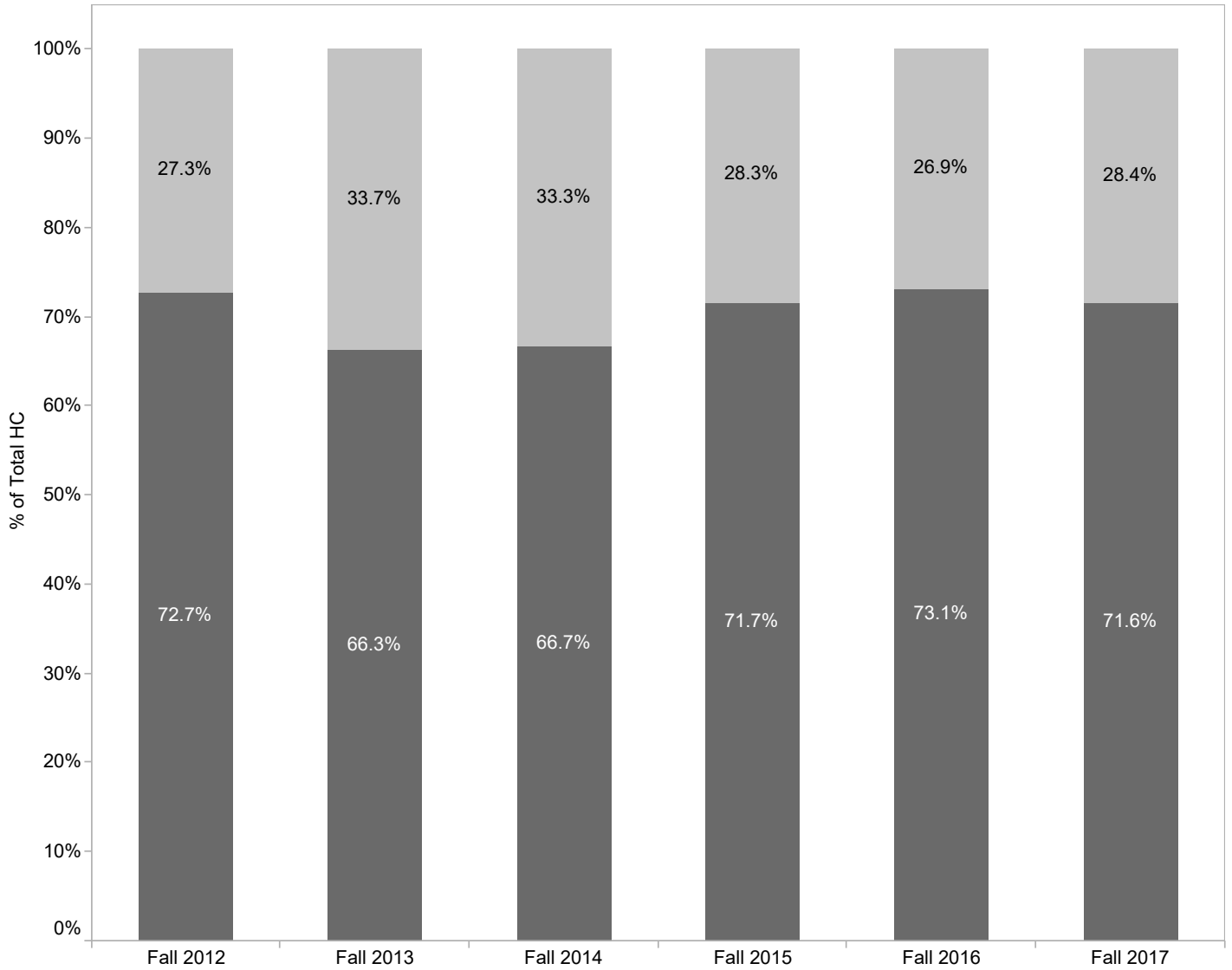

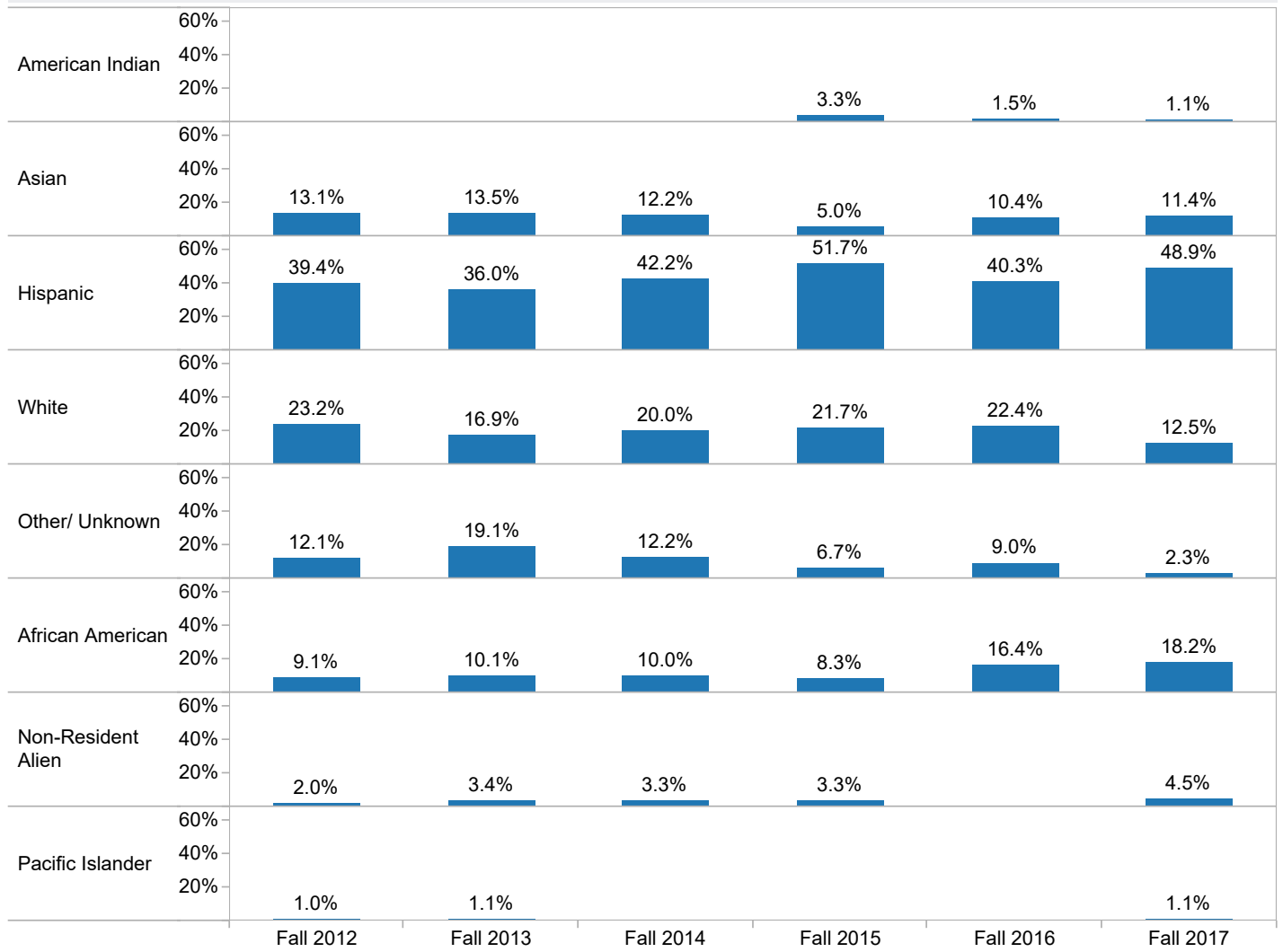
