1. Describe your reading assessment tools for XX graders.
2. What will you do after the assessments are completed?
3. How would you use Guided Reading? Share with me some skills and strategies you might try to teach.
4. Describe your overall reading program.
5. Share with me a five-day reading plan based on an anthology (basal) text or grade level story.
6. How would you go about teaching writing?
7. What would you do if you had several ELL students and below-grade-level readers?
8. What reading program would you design for grade-level and above students?
9. How do you implement individualized reading instruction plans?
10. What do you know about Accelerated Reading programs? How would it be implemented?
11. How do you go about selecting appropriate, grade-level literature?
12. What other Guided Reading would you use besides teacher read-alouds to whole class or small groups?

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Interview Preparation (Grade Level specific per your indication):

1. Be an expert on Guided Reading and Writer's Workshop.
2. Know the names of the appropriate testing assessments.
3. Be able to share 5-10 specific reading skills you could teach.
4. Know where to find reading support literature.
5. Have a plan in mind for a multi-level classroom reading program.
