Verification of Pre-Program Field Experience

To be admitted to a Kremen School Credential program, credential applicants must have 45 hours of field experience from an accredited K-12 public school classroom or a classroom-like setting PRIOR to admission to the credential program. A minimum of 30 hours must occur in the grade level or subject area appropriate to the desired credential.

The purpose of the field experience is to provide the applicant with the opportunity to engage with the population they are seeking to teach in order to have a clear assessment of their interest in the teaching profession and their potential in the field. The early Field experience needs to be within the last five years.
