

**International Education Committee**  
**Online Meeting Notes**  
**May 5 - 12, 2014**

1. Congratulations to Jyothi, who has been elected Chair of the IEC starting in August 2014.

2. In an email poll of IEC members, most had voted not to have a meeting, or were unavailable for an IEC meeting in May. This online “meeting” was needed to finalize a few items of business for the academic year. Members were asked to send responses to Diane for the action items by Monday, May 12, 2014.
