- 1. Approval of minutes.** Approved as corrected.
- 2. Discussion of Strategies for Goal 11**
 - a. Don and Diane worked on revising the wording for Strategy 1 and extended the dates in the table. A copy was distributed for discussion. No changes were suggested.
 - b. Sarah and Cindy provided some information on the visit by university presidents from China. The presidents are exploring potential 1-2-1 programs. Sarah said they would be interested in an Education Administration master's program tailored to their needs.
 - c. Discussion ensued about replacing Strategy 2 with exploration of a 1-2-1 program in Education Administration for China. A motion was made and passed.

 - a. Teresa will be at a conference in New Mexico, so cannot participate in the International Week panel.
