Introduction or Set (9/10 points):

What a fun opening with Dora! She will capture the kids' attention!
Focus on getting them locked into the content first...then go over the rules.

Procedure (19/20 points):

The blindfold idea was great!
Good questioning and exploration of the senses!
While in the pond area lots of inquiry was initiated!
Indoors the questioning became less of an invitation to inquire.
Thoughtful summary inquiry question, "How will you notice the world?"

Assessment (9/10 points):

Students were drawing their observations in the five senses book.
Ask more of the students and their book. Have them describe what they observed and communicate some of the details of their observations.
Instead of the question, "Why don't you guys turn to a partner and tell them what you saw?" ... Make it a statement: "Turn to a partner and..."

Classroom Management / Style (10/10 points):

Teachers are professional and respectful!
Dora script was thoughtfully executed! For example, Dora, "I know what 'predict' means!"
Students were very engaged and interested!
