1. Approval of Agenda-Add the MA Reading online program to the agenda-Approved as amended
2. Approval of Minutes-approval of minutes tabled for next meeting.
3. Second Reading: MA in Ed (Option in Multilingual & Multicultural Education) – Teresa Huerta-Program made all suggested changes. Identified LEE 282 as the GWR. Minor adjustments to the matrix for program. Motion to approve the Multilingual and Multicultural MA in Ed option with suggested changes-Approved.
4. Program Changes in Special Education – Elisa Jamgochian-The program provided the comparison suggested by the committee of the old Special Education program vs the new changes. Minor changes were suggested by the committee. SPED 246 and SPED 247 formerly SPED 137 and 147 have been changed to meet the new CTC standards so now the course is properly identified as 200 level. It has maintained its advanced content. SPED 243 is a new research course. SPED 219 is just changing the name to Effective Communication and Collaborative Partnerships and add a statement of perquisites and omit ERA 153 as a prerequisite to the program. SPED 235 and SPED 236 are two new credential courses in the clear program. Motion to approve changes to the MA in Special Education program, course changes and additions, along with the catalog changes.-Approved
5. Rehab 268D- Carol Rankin- Previously 280T course that needs to be assigned a number. Course prepares graduate students to work with young adults who have developmental, learning and/or physical disabilities, transition toward independence. 6. MA in Reading (online)-Glenn DeVoogd- The MA in Reading is our newest online program and has been active since Fall 2012. The catalog description of the program and course outline never made the catalog. Motion to approve the description of the program and course outline for the MA in Reading.- Approved.
