Co-Teaching

- 194 total participants
- 4 co-teaching workshops with both components
- All phases had co-teaching overview as part of seminar (Kien Pham and Jose Lomeli facilitated for EHD 178 and EHD 170; supervisors facilitated with EHD 174)
- Revamped handbook to require co-teaching strategy listed in lesson plans
- Ready to change the organization of workshops, focus on pairs workshops with less of the overview of co-teaching
- Building co-teaching library of books and videos
- Not sure if there is money in the spring to keep it going
- Biggest expense is for subs during the week; and small stipend for teachers on Saturday
