WORKSHOP to prepare you for the CSET MATHEMATICS SUBTEST I

Individuals seeking a teaching credential can show subject matter knowledge by passing the appropriate subject matter assessments of the California Teacher Commission-approved California Subject Examinations for Teachers (CSET).

This **workshop on algebra and number theory will target the January 10 CSET test date** by covering the subject matter needed to pass the first CSET exam for mathematics teaching (CSET Mathematics Subtest I--for more information on topics covered on this test, see http://www.cset.nesinc.com/CS_testguide_Mathopener.asp).

If you pass CSET Math Subtests I and II, you are eligible for a Foundational-Level Math (FLM) Credential if you already have a Single Subject Credential. If you have a Multiple Subject Credential, you can apply for the FLM credential once you pass a Single Subject methods course (CI 161 at Fresno State). The FLM credential allows you to teach Algebra and Geometry at any grade level.
