Steps a Graduate Program Application Follows

Step 1: Your program application is processed and set up for review by the program committee.

You also must apply to CSUF. This can be accomplished by going to; www.csumentor.edu. Please make sure you choose the correct semester and program. If you missed the deadline, contact the Graduate Technician.

Check your "My Fresno State Student Center" at my.csufresno.edu for updates on admission status

Step 2: Your university admission will either take place during the processing of your program admission, or shortly after, "IF" you have turned in all CSUF admission requirements.

Check your CSU Fresno email frequently from this point on. CSUF's main method of communication with you is through email!

Program Admission Letter Terminology

***Classified-**Fully admitted to program.

***Conditional-** Program admission requirements still pending. Complete the pending items and notify the Graduate Technician.

***Denied-**We were not able to admit at this time.

Step 3: If you are admissible to the program, you will receive your admittance letter via mail only. The letter will include information about status, your academic advisor, missing items, if any, and your next step.

Expect delays in processing if you submit your application close to or after deadlines!

Step 4: You will receive an email and/or letter from CSUF's Graduate Admissions Office stating that you have been admitted to the university and program. Look for registration dates at this point.
