

- Female Male

- White students are the only student population that has a higher percentage of continuing generation students than first generation students.
  - A smaller percentage of White students require mandatory remediation in English and/or Mathematics compared to the other student groups.
  - They have the highest retention and graduation rates (except Native American graduation rates, which has a small number of students).
