
ZOOM Info!

Zoom is a great platform to video conference, video chat and video learn and it's what we will use for our OLLI offerings.

It takes just a minute to get a FREE Zoom account. Please do not be intimidated: You can learn anything!

From your desktop or laptop computer:

Go to <u>www.zoom.us</u> and click the blue box that says "sign up".



NOTE: You do not need to upgrade or pay for your account to participate in the OLLI Zoom. Our license is through the university and allows you to participate fully. If you decide to host your own Zoom meetings with family, friends or interest groups, you may wish to upgrade someday - but there is no need to for OLLI.

From your phone or tablet:

Apple device (iPhone, iPad) download Zoom from the Apple App store Android device (phone or tablet that's not an Apple product) download Zoom from the Google Play Store
