## CORRECTIONAL OFFICER

### REQUIREMENTS

- At least 21 years of age.
- Completion of thirty (30) semester units of academic course work from an accredited college or university that is acceptable within the United States' accredited college or university system *or* two (2) years of United States Military service with an honorable discharge.
- Possession of a valid Class "C" driver's license or equivalent. Incumbents may be required to obtain a valid Class "B" driver's license or equivalent (does not have to be a California license).
- Successful completion of the mandated exam by the California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC).
- Pass a background investigation, polygraph, psychological and medical examination.

### BENEFITS

- \$3,165.50 - \$4,051.67 monthly salary.
- Bilingual pay.
- Night shift differential pay.
- Paid vacation and sick leave accrual.
- Medical, dental and vision coverage.
- Flexible spending account program.
- Deferred compensation plans.
