*Completion rate for 4 semesters (2 years): $3/12 = 25\%$

**Completion rate for 6 semesters (3 years): $7/12 = 58.3\%$

***Completion rate for 8 semesters (4 years): $7/12 = 58.3\%$

NOTES:

(1) The MPA program is 36 semester-units in length. It is designed for a full-time graduate student (nine units per semester) to finish in two academic years (four semesters).

(2) According to university policy, students have five academic years (10 semesters) to complete work on their master’s degrees.

(3) The numbers in each successive column are cumulative, which means the number of students in the column for the 150% of program degree length include students graduating in four semesters and those graduating in six semesters. The same formula applies to the number of students in the final column, 200% of program degree length.
