2006 Recruitment Regulations
Clarifications

- I a. The new NPC Release Figure Method will be used. The NPC Area Specialist will determine this figures and communicate them to the Panhellenic Advisor.
- I d. Quota additions will be determined by the Bid Matching group during the process and agreed upon according to NPC guidelines.
- I g. Quota is the number of women each chapter is guaranteed to receive during formal recruitment. Should a chapter have Quota vacancies after formal recruitment those spaces are still able to be filled during COB that semester even if this causes the chapter to exceed Total.
- I h. According to NPC early alumni status women are still counted toward total. Total is currently 50 members. Total may only be exceeded during formal recruitment when a sorority takes Quota.
- I j. A chapter may only Snap a woman who is a registered PNM that is somewhere on their final list. Snapping shall be conducted immediately following the Bid Matching process and only chapters that have Quota vacancies are eligible. Snapping will be coordinated with the Panhellenic Advisor.
- I l. The term “party” shall be replaced with “event” to be in line with the suggestions of NPC. An event is one session within a round of recruitment. For example there are 2 Preference night events.
- II a. Although we are moving toward Partially Structured Recruitment (PSR), the period of fall recruitment will still be referred to as FORMAL RECRUITMENT.
- II b. Snapping will occur during those times unless advised by the Panhellenic Advisor.
- II e. Bid Matching will occur tentatively at 10:00 PM on Sunday, September 17, 2006 in USU 308. Chapters will be responsible for ensuring a maximum of tow (2) alumni advisors are present. Chapters must turn in to the Panhellenic Advisor the contact information (including email, phone and address) of their recruitment advisor and key alumni advisor. The Chapter and the Panhellenic Advisor will notify alumni advisors of Bid Matching details. Chapters will be

responsible for notifying visiting chapter consultants, traveling leadership consultants or regional recruitment specialists.

II f. During the breaks between events, PNMs will be asked to refrain from discussions and talking. Recruitment Counselors (Row Chis) will advise PNMs that there should be limited to no talking during these breaks.

II g. During the breaks between events, PNMs will be asked to refrain from discussions and talking. Recruitment Counselors (Row Chis) will advise PNMs that there should be limited to no talking during these breaks.

II j. spelling correction: “Chapters will be *assessed...*” Please note that the fees assessed to chapters for late lists are equivalent to \$1 per minute [s] late. With each list chapters will be expected to submit through the ICS system a list of women who attended their events that night. This feature is under Daily Select—previous day visits. This feature will also indicate for the chapter if the woman is a legacy as an added reminder. Below are the times each list will be due:

- Friday, September 15th, 2006 lists from Sisterhood Night will be due at 10:30 PM
- Saturday, September 16th, 2006 lists from Philanthropy Afternoon will be due at 8:00 PM
- Sunday, September 17th, 2006 Bid lists are due at 9:00 PM

II k. spelling correction: “Chapters will be *assessed...*” The end of the event will be defined by the time the last PNM exits the chapter house. Fees will be assessed using this time for each respective house.

II l. spelling correction: “Chapters will be *assessed...*” Fees will also be assessed for late bid acceptance forms given out after the Formal Recruitment process—these need to be turned in to the Panhellenic Advisor (in USU 306), PHC VP Membership, or PHC President (in their houses) within 24 hours of the bid being offered. This includes weekends and holidays.

II n. This year the registration form will include questions with answers:

- Are you interested in moving-in to a sorority house in the fall?
- Are you interested in moving-in to a sorority house in the spring?
- Do your parents know you have registered for recruitment?
- Are your parents supportive?
- Are you able to attend all events?
- Are you going through recruitment with a friend?
- Do you know anyone in a sorority?
- What do you hope to get out of recruitment?
- Do you have any other questions?
- Any Addition Information you would like to provide

II o. PNMs will be able to upload pictures on-line when they register with ICS. Should a woman choose to do this, the pictures will be able to be viewed by the chapter.

II p. Recruitment budgets shall not exceed \$325 for event days (see below for the breakdown).

Chapters will submit budgets by Friday, September 8th at 5:00 PM to USU 306 (please use the example budget in this packet).

- Sisterhood \$150
- Philanthropy \$100
- Preference \$75

** addition \$5 per woman each round on accessories**

** Bid Day \$20 per woman **

spelling correction: "All items used in the house, *borrowed*..."

II q. Chapters should expect visits during any and all events except Preference. Row Chis and Panhellenic Executive members will come at the start of the event and announce themselves.

II s. Chapters may be visited before events begin for the day. So as to prevent rushed alterations for compliance, Panhellenic will conduct early inspections with helpful reminders about the new rules. **Chapters will be visited on Friday, September 8th between 2:00 PM and 5:00 PM. Should a chapter wish to request a specific time they must do so via email to lawilliams@csufresno.edu**

III Additions:

- f. In the case a Panhellenic Officer or Recruitment Counselor need to enter their respective chapter house from the end of orientation to before bid day activities they must be accompanied by at least 2 other disaffiliated members, at least one of which not from the same chapter. This includes using the restroom during recruitment events.
- g. The use of cell phones, text messaging, email, and any other form of communication between a disaffiliated member and her respective chapter will be prohibited during recruitment and if needed cell phones will be collected by the Panhellenic President, VP membership or Advisor.

IV Addition:

- i. The use of cell phones, text messaging, email, and any other form of communication between a disaffiliated member and her respective chapter will be prohibited during recruitment and if needed cell phones will be collected by the Panhellenic President, VP membership or Advisor to prevent this from occurring.

V b. A full time student is defined as one attempting 12 credits or more.
