B.A.G. (Bust A Gut) of Laughs

B.A.G. (Bust A Gut) of Laughs is responsible for providing various style of humorous expression. (i.e. comedians, hypnotists, magicians, and other entertainers.)

Big Screen

Big Screen is responsible for offering a wide-selection of free films in various areas of cinema. (i.e. foreign films, animations, shorts blockbusters, independent films, et al.) Past events include Shocktober and the Animation Film Festival.

Celebrations & Festivals

Celebrations and Festivals is responsible for presenting theme celebrations and events emphasizing social and cultural awareness. Past events include the Diversity Week, the Poetry Series, and the Dia de los Muertos celebration.

CenterStage

CenterStage is responsible for presenting a rich selection of artistic expressions through the performing and visual arts. Past artists include the Alvin Ailey Repertory Ensemble, Poncho Sanchez Latin Jazz Ensemble, Trinity Irish Dance Company, Les Ballets jazz de Montreal, Lily Cai Chinese Dance Company, Ensemble Galilei, Lulu Washington Dance Theater, the Tibetan Monks from the Drepung Loseling Monastery, The International Guitar Night, and the Moscow Boys Choir.

The Music Scene

The Music Scene is responsible for creating a musical environment by showcasing a wide selection of artists. Past events have included Hootie and the Blowfish, Bush and Moby, Tool, Offspring, the Wallflowers, Smokin' Grooves, Isley Brothers & Ohio Players as well as several local and regional bands.

The Point

The Point is responsible for addressing student concerns and creating dialogue through speakers, debates panel discussions, open forums, and other events.

Public Relations & Marketing

Public Relations & Marketing communicates with on and off campus organizations about USU Productions and activities. As well as develops and maintains contact with media outlets. It also markets USU Productions and its events to students and the public

Recreation & Leisure

Recreation and Leisure is responsible for offering opportunities to participate in leisure, social and recreational activities. Past events have included the San Francisco Shopping Trip, the Soccer Tournament and Whitewater River Rafting.

Special Events
