

## Readmission Steps for Disqualified Students

- STEP 1** Complete all Lower Division General Education
- STEP 2** If all Lower Division General Education and Lower Division Major courses have been completed, there must be a minimum of 6 units completed in courses that are major or career related.
- STEP 3** Must demonstrate academic success in courses taken through Open University or other accredited institution(s) and obtain a minimum of a 2.50 GPA in those courses.

**STEP 4** Re-Apply for admission to the University by completing the CSU Admissions Application\* at <https://www.calstate.edu/apply>. Application time line for fall is October 1st - February 1st. **STEP 5** After you submit your Admissions Application, a Readmission Petition with a due date will be **sent to you**. This could take 4-6 weeks.

**STEP 6** Once you have been Readmitted look for registration time on your Student Center

**STEP 8** Meet with your MAJOR academic advisor

**STEP 9** Meet all Probation requirements
