- 🐾 Our university is formally called “California State University, Fresno” and informally known as “Fresno State.”
- 🐾 The average student takes five years to graduate with a first bachelor's degree.
- 🐾 Our university offers a Four-Year Graduation Plan for first-time freshmen.
- 🐾 Students should not overload on the number of units taken during the first year at Fresno State. It is generally recommended that students enroll in 14 to 16 units.
- 🐾 We have an on campus University Health and Psychological Services Center which is staffed by medical professionals. The facility offers high quality health care to students at little or no cost. A few of the services offered include: treatment of illness and injuries, a full pharmacy, gynecology, health education, immunizations, lab tests, psychological counseling, and x-rays.
