University Health & Psychological Services (UHPS)

UHPS can help students with most of the health and psychological problems they encounter, and we encourage students to utilize these services. UHPS provides the immunization required by the university (see the ***Class Schedule*** or UHPS website for more information), as well as other, elective, immunizations.

The medical staff includes six full-time physicians, five nurse-practitioners, a number of part-time specialist physicians, and specialists in laboratory, X-ray, Physical Therapy, Pharmacy, Health Education, and Nutrition.

Counseling for personal and emotional issues is available by appointment and on a walk-in basis. Walk-in hours are 9 to 11 a.m. and 2 to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

UHPS Hours: Services are available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:45 p.m., except when the campus is closed for holidays. Summer hours are Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Fees: After students pay their mandatory health fee at the time of registration, basic health services are provided at no charge throughout the semester. Counseling services are always free of charge. There are modest charges for certain medical services, such as pharmaceuticals, certain immunizations, and medical tests that are sent to an outside laboratory.
