

Q: Is it true that once you complete your G.E. requirements and your major classes you will automatically graduate?

A: No. Depending on your major, you will have a certain number of required electives that you must take before you can graduate. Also, graduation is not automatic. You must apply for graduation during the specified time during the term (fall, spring, or summer) in which you hope to graduate.

SUMMARY OF DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Check when completed:

- 1. Total units (120 units minimum)
- 2. Major requirements
- 3. General Education (51 units*), including:
 - 1999-2000 to present catalog years**
 - FOUNDATION** (12 units)
 - BREADTH** (27 units)
 - INTEGRATION** (9 upper division units)
 - MULTICULTURAL/INTERNATIONAL** (3 upper division units)
- 4. Upper Division Writing Skills (after 60 units completed)**
 - Passing the Upper Division Writing Examination (UDWE)--consult Testing Center
 - or**
 - Passing a "W" course** with a grade of C/CR or higher
- 5. Residence units requirement (30 units total: 24 upper division, 12 in major, 9 in G.E.)
- 6. 40 units of upper division course work
- 7. GPA of 2.0+ in three areas: (a) in the major, (b) in all coursework taken at Fresno State, and (c) total/cumulative units (some departments require a 2.0 in every class)
- 8. Pay graduation fee at the Cashier's window during the published filing period of the semester you plan to graduate
- 9. File graduation application with cashier's receipt at the Evaluations Office during the published filing period of the semester you plan to graduate

*NOTE: Majors in Engineering and Liberal Studies must complete a different G.E. pattern. A faculty advisor should be consulted for specific requirements.

**A few majors require a specific "W" course.
