

Most advisors can print a DARS report for you. The DARS report will show your progress toward completing a degree program. Your advisor will be able to request “what if” scenarios on-line to assist in the decision of changing major programs or catalogs. DARS also takes the “guesswork” out of selecting courses for future enrollment. The report indicates which requirements and courses have been completed and which requirements and courses still need to be taken.

How Do You Get a DARS Progress Report?

Your initial DARS Progress Report will be mailed to you by the Evaluations Office during the first or second semester you are enrolled at Fresno State. After you have received this report, contact your academic advisor for further information.
