

## POSSIBLE CLASSES FOR FIRST-TIME TRANSFERS

### Lower Division General Education (courses numbered 1-99)

Take any lower division G.E. classes that you know you still need.

### Upper Division General Education (courses numbered 100-199)

Take upper division G.E. classes you know you need as long as you have or will have 60 semester units at the end of your first semester at Fresno State and have met prerequisites, if any.

If your catalog year is 1988-89 through 1998-99, choose from **BREADTH** or one or two of your **CAPSTONE** classes.

If your catalog year is 1999-2000 to present and you have met the prerequisites, choose from **INTEGRATION** and/or **MULTICULTURAL/ INTERNATIONAL**. Make sure your selections are **not** from your major department.

### Upper Division Writing Skills Requirement

Depending on what your major requires, you may be able to pass an examination (Upper Division Writing Exam) or take a class to meet this requirement. Consult the current **Class Schedule** for a complete listing of classes.

To receive upper division credit for the “W” class, you must have completed 60 or more semester units which count toward graduation by the end of the term in which you take the class.

### Major classes

Take beginning major courses that you know you need.

### Minor or certificate classes

Earn elective units by pursuing a minor (ranging from 15 to 24 units) or a certificate (usually 12 units) in areas of high interest to you.
