

REMEDIATION ADVISORY

Policy: CSU Executive Order 665 requires all new students who do not pass the EPT/ELM placement exams to complete remediation requirements by the end of their second semester at a CSU campus.

The following information describes options available for students who did not complete remediation during their first two semesters (Fall 2013-Spring 2014) at Fresno State. **Remediation requirements must be completed with a grade of "C" or better before the beginning of a third semester of attendance at Fresno State.** A sample list of English and Math remedial courses accepted by Fresno State is available at www.fresnostate.edu/are.

The following options are based on the **Academic Standing** at the end of the second semester at Fresno State. Students should login to their Student Center and review their transcript with the updated final Academic Standing after June 4, 2014.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Good • Probation • DQ-Readmitted 	<p><u>OPTION 1: Summer 2014</u> - Complete the required remedial course in the summer and maintain continuing student status for Fall 2014.</p> <p>Students who choose to enroll in a summer class can fax or email a confirmation of their enrollment to Fresno State. The email is remediation@csufresno.edu and the fax number is (559) 278-4812. The email/fax should be addressed with the subject "Summer remediation class" and should include the student's Fresno State ID number and phone number. The final Grade Report/Transcript is due by Friday, August 8, 2014. Please note that students who are financial aid recipients will have a hold placed on their financial aid disbursement. Students who are not able to complete remediation by this date are not eligible to return in the fall and should consider option 2 listed below.</p>
	<p><u>OPTION 2: One-Semester Stop Out (Fall 2014)</u> – Students can apply to attend another university or community college for the fall 2014 semester and complete their remediation requirement. Students who satisfy their remediation requirement and wish to register at Fresno State for the Spring 2015 semester without reapplying may do so after the final official transcript is received. Students who enrolled at Fresno State in Fall classes and are selecting this option should login to the Student Center and drop their class schedule. <i>Students choosing to return in a semester beyond Spring 2015 will need to reapply for admissions.</i></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disqualified 	<p>Disqualified students are expected to demonstrate the ability to be successful in college level work before they can be considered for readmission. Students are encouraged to attend a community college or other university in the Fall to complete remediation requirements and to complete baccalaureate level courses that fulfill General Education or major requirements. Students are also encouraged to consult with an advisor about options for repairing the academic record and getting into good standing. Students will need to reapply for admissions.
