ASI Funding Application Deadlines

(FRESNO, Calif.)- Applications for Instructionally Related Activities (IRA) and the Dr. Pete Mehas Grant are due Friday, March 7, 2014 by 5 p.m. in the ASI office located on the second floor of the University Student Union Room 317.

IRA Funds are received through student fees and are used to fund student experiences that are academic, but not available through the classroom. Activities must be departmentally based and sponsored, integral to course offerings, intensive and structured activities, require active rather than passive student involvement, and engage students in performances, presentations, or competitions that demonstrate skills from participation in intensive class work.

The Dr. Pete Mehas Memorial Grant is a one-time funding opportunity that allows departments within the eight academic colleges or schools at Fresno State to apply for a grant worth up to \$5,000. The grants are to be expended exclusively on technology or equipment that is necessary to help students succeed at Fresno State.

“Dr. Pete Mehas was an inspirational advocate for education, and a member of ASI many years ago. I highly encourage all Department Chairs and College Deans to collaborate with their respective ASI Senator to submit an application for the Dr. Pete Mehas Memorial Grant,” said Rebecca Rosengarten, ASI VP of Finance. “These grants go towards funding technology and equipment that directly benefit current Fresno State students with their academic success.”
