ASI Sponsored Activity Funding Increase

(FRESNO, Calif.)- One of the major services that Associated Students Incorporated (ASI) offers to Fresno State students is the ability to receive club funding for events that are held on campus, free and open to all students. Clubs and organizations must be recognized by Fresno State in order to be eligible to receive funding.

ASI has proudly funded over 100 Fresno State student clubs this academic year and applications are still coming in. Due to the high demand of funding and a recent increase to the amount each club may be awarded (from \$2,000 to \$3,000 this fall semester) the ASI Finance Committee has reached their maximum budget.

The committee will ask the Senate for the allocation of \$35,000 from reserves to continue offering sponsored funding for the 2013-2014 school year, bringing the total budgeted to \$120,000.
