### **ASI Hosts 4th Annual Fresno State 101**

Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) is hosting its fourth annual Fresno State 101, a three-week workshop series designed to educate students on the structure of Fresno State, the CSU system, and leadership opportunities within both. FS 101 will showcase the importance of student representatives within the university and will provide leadership training for on and off campus positions.

The first of three workshops will take place today, January 26 at 4 p.m. in USU 312-314. The discussion will focus on the importance of student representatives and ways the CSU system produces graduates.

The second workshop will take place on Tuesday, February 2 at 4 p.m. in USU 312-314. This workshop focuses on the fundamental building blocks of Fresno State.

The third and final workshop will be on Tuesday, February 9 at 4 p.m. in USU 312-314 and will highlight ways leaders are transformed into advocates here at Fresno State.

The program is free and open to students who register on Orgsync within the program capacity. All students who complete the program will receive a Student Representative certificate signed by the University President as well as a plaque.
