



A Resolution Supporting the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act

WHEREAS, Associated Students Inc. is the recognized student body government of California State University, Fresno; and

WHEREAS, the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act eliminates a distinction in existing tax law that would result in allowing tax-exempt charitable and educational organizations to make grants to non-University owned not-for-profit student housing entities that provide collegiate student housing; and

WHEREAS, the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act would make college more affordable at no cost to taxpayers by offering a housing alternative less expensive than University housing; and

WHEREAS, the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act results in safer student housing by encouraging charitable contributions to collegiate housing for installation of life saving equipment such as fire sprinklers, smoke detectors, and alarm systems; and therefore be it

RESOLVED, that ASI supports Congressional passage of the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act; and be it further

RESOLVED, that ASI asks the California Congressional Delegation to sponsor the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act; and be it finally

RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be distributed widely, including, but not limited to, the Collegian, the Fresno Bee, and the California Congressional Delegation.
