



Requirements for Student Representatives

Grades

All applicants must be enrolled and in good standing at the university. Applicants must have received at least a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) in the prior semester, earned a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 for all college work, and have at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA for all work at Fresno State. Graduate students must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA in all graduate work. Applicants may not be on probation of any kind.

Unit Load

Undergraduate applicants must maintain 6 units per semester when applying/holding a position. Graduate and credential students must maintain 3 units per semester while applying/holding a position. Undergraduate students are allowed to earn a maximum of 150 semester units or 125 percent of the units required for a specific baccalaureate degree objective, whichever is greater. Graduate and credential students are allowed to earn a maximum of 50 semester units or 167 percent of the units required for a graduate or credential objective, whichever is greater.

Residency

Undergraduate applicants must have been enrolled on the campus and have completed at least one semester prior to the current, earning a total of 6 semester units during that year. Graduate and credential student applicants must earn 6 units per semester of continuous attendance as a new graduate or credential student to be eligible. Graduate and credential students who received a bachelor's degree or credential within the past three years from the same campus must have earned a total of 12 semester units during their last year as an undergraduate to be eligible.

Special Notes:

Under extraordinary circumstances the campus president may make an exception to the requirements for unit load, maximum allowable units, residency, and GPA.

All applicants will have their grades and units verified to ensure all student representatives have met the California State University standards for grades (2.0 GPA each semester, 3.0 GPA for graduate students), units earned (6 per semester for undergraduates, 3 per semester for graduate and credential students), and maximum allowable units required for a degree or credential (150 for undergraduates, 50 for graduate and credential students). Applicants failing to meet any of the requirements will no longer be permitted to serve.
