T-shirt Exchange Program

Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) is giving Fresno State students an opportunity to rock Bulldog gear for Homecoming Week by bringing back the T-shirt Exchange program. The program is designed to increase the Bulldog pride on campus by reducing the number of shirts worn from other campuses.

The T-Shirt Exchange, previously done in 2009-2010, allows students to exchange apparel from other schools (including high schools and other colleges) for a Fresno State t-shirt. This program will kick-off with homecoming week, Monday, October 14.

Students are encouraged to bring used t-shirts into the ASI programs office, located on the second floor of the University Student Union, room 316. In exchange, students be given a new Fresno State t-shirt.
