An Advising Tool

DARS (Degree Audit Reporting System) is an advising tool. It is a system-generated report which shows your progress toward completing your General Education (G.E.), declared major courses, and remaining degree requirements.

What Does DARS Do for You?

- Generates a report showing progress in your chosen primary degree program
- Allows for “what if” scenarios for different majors and catalog years
- Takes the “guesswork” out of selecting courses for future enrollment
- Allows advisors to focus on advising
- Provides consistent interpretation of degree requirements
