# Admission Steps for Dream Students

### AB 540:

- a. Students must attend at least three years and graduate from a California high school or obtain its equivalent (GED).
- b. Students must sign an affidavit stating their California residency.
- c. All information must be handled in a confidential manner.

### AB 2000:

- a. This bill clarifies that a student who secures three years of high school credit or has a total of three or more years of attendance in a California elementary school, middle school, or high school, or a combination of those schools, is eligible for AB 540.
- b. Students must graduate from a California high school or obtain its equivalent.

### SB 68:

- a. Expands the graduation requirements to include California Community Colleges and California adult schools.
- b. Full-time attendance at a California Community College shall comprise of a minimum of 12 units per semester or 420 class hours per year and shall not exceed two years.
- c. Full-time attendance at a California adult school shall be a minimum of 420 class hours for each school year.

## 1. Apply to Fresno State:

- Complete the CSU application between October 1& November 30  
<https://www2.calstate.edu/apply>
- If you don't have a social security number, leave it blank
- Include your DACA social security number if you have one
- When asked about your citizenship status, click "None"
- When asked if you claim California residency, click "Yes"
- You can request a fee waiver
- Submit application and keep confirmation

## 2. Apply for EOP (Educational Opportunity Program):

- In the CSU Apply Application, click "Yes" when asked if you are interested in EOP
- Complete the EOP application (located in the 'Personal Information' section of application)
- Provide names and emails of faculty/staff recommending you
- Call EOP to make sure your application has been submitted. (559) 278-6025

- 3. Submit Residency Documentation:**
  - Submit CSU [Residency Questionnaire](#).
  - Submit the [California Non-Resident Tuition Exemption Form](#)
  - Submit your K-12 unofficial school attendance records. (You only need to show 3 years of attendance)
  
- 4. Create your Fresno State email account:**
  - Fresno State will send you an email with instructions to create your email account
  - Use your full name as the username & create password

- 10. Apply for California Financial Assistance:**
  - Apply for Cal Dream act at <https://dream.csac.ca.gov/> (October 1 – March 2)
  - Make sure that your high school/college submits your GPA verification to CSAC
  - All male students must register for the Selective Service
  
- 11. Create an account with Web Grants:**
  - <https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/logon.asp>
  - Constantly check your status.
  - Submit all required financial aid documentation to the financial aid office or CSAC ASAP
  
- 12. Confirm Your Intent to Enroll:**
  - Fresno State will send you an email asking you to confirm your intent to enroll
  - You must reply by May 1<sup>st</sup>
  
- 13. Register for Dog Days New Student Orientation:**
  - Pay and register for Dog Days by May 1<sup>st</sup>
  - You can request a fee waiver
  
- 14. Attend Mandatory Dream Student Workshop during Dog Days New Student Orientation:**
  - You will receive an email invitation with the time and location for the workshop
  - Please contact the Dream Success Center if you do not receive an email invitation
