The Federal TEACH Grant Program provides grant funds to students who are completing coursework needed to begin a career in teaching, and who agree to serve for at least four years as a full-time, highly qualified teacher in a high-need field, in a school serving low-income students. Eligible full-time students may be eligible to receive up to \$1,864 per semester in TEACH Grant funds. If you receive a TEACH Grant but do not complete the required teaching service requirements, all TEACH Grant funds will be converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan that you must repay, with accrued interest, to the Department of Education. **Once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to a grant.**

TEACH GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Undergraduate Credential Graduate
- Complete and submit the TEACH Grant Request Form to the Financial Aid Office.
- Attach a signed Education Plan from my advisor/department head, who is familiar with my teaching program/career goals to the Financial Aid Office. The Education Plan must be on department/school letterhead.
- Completed and submitted the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Meet first-year TEACH Grant determination GPA requirements.
 - Undergraduates: Must have a final high school cumulative GPA of 3.25 or greater to be eligible.
 - Graduates: Must have an undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.25 or greater to be eligible.
- Maintain a 3.25 minimum GPA for subsequent year TEACH Grant award requests.
- Be enrolled at least half-time in an eligible program during: **FALL 2016** **SPRING 2017**
- Complete the TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATS) at: <https://teach-ats.ed.gov/ats/studentHome.action> **before** TEACH Grant funds are awarded.
- Complete TEACH Grant Counseling at: <https://teach-ats.ed.gov/ats/studentHome.action> **before** TEACH funds are awarded.
- Be enrolled in a high-need field/program that leads towards teaching in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families.
 - ▶ **Current high-need** fields are the following specific subject areas:
 - Bilingual education and English language acquisition
 - Foreign language
 - Mathematics
 - Reading specialist
 - Science
 - Special education
 - Multiple subject
