

## 2017-2018 Bulldog Retention Grant

As part of the Fresno State Graduation initiative, limited one-time funding is available to assist students who have a financial aid shortfall and are subject to being dropped from classes. Maximum awards will be \$1500 per student. Priority funding will be provided to students in their last term/semester at the university.

### Eligibility Criteria:

- 1) Have a balance on your student account after all financial aid and scholarships have been applied
- 2) Undergraduate and CA Resident for tuition purposes
- 3) Must be enrolled in at least 6 units
- 4) Must be an undergraduate degree seeking student
- 5) Be in a good academic standing and meet SAP (Satisfactory Academic Progress)
- 6) Have 30 units or less to graduate
- 7) Have not received a Bulldog Grant in the past
- 8) Tuition & Fee Balance after grants, scholarships and waivers

- If a recipient receives additional aid after the Bulldog Retention Grant is awarded, the grant will be reduced.
