Transcripts must be requested by the tax filer directly from IRS either online at www.irs.gov or by calling 1-800-908-9946. It can take up to 10 days for IRS to process the request.

DO NOT LEAVE ANY ITEMS BLANK. Enter zero ("0") under "Amount" if you did not work and/or had no income. Leaving the "Amount" section blank is not an acceptable response.
