Visual Learners:

 <p>Remember material best when they see what is being taught</p>	 <p>Are able to visualize maps and directions</p>	 <p>Prefer to read information in a text or on a whiteboard, rather than listen to lecture</p>	 <p>Enjoy doodling and drawing</p>
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Note Taking/Studying:



Sit where you can see the instructor and visual aids well.

Avoid visual distractions (windows, open doors, computer screens, etc.)

Use visual aids, such as symbols

Highlight or use multi-colored pens

Rewrite notes using 3:1 (visual to words) picture pages

Use flashcards



Use concept maps (mind mapping or "tree charts")

Create visual pictures in your mind of key topics
