University 1: An Introduction To The University

Fresno State offers University 1, a three-unit course, to guide you through the academic process. Everyone has questions when first entering a university. University 1 answers many of those questions as it helps you master the demands of attending a four-year school. This course helps you develop skills for lifelong learning and achievement and it prepares you for advanced study.

University 1 presents strategies for keeping ahead academically, managing time effectively, and graduating on schedule. This course helps you build self-confidence as you set goals and explore career options. It is designed to expand your intellectual horizons as you gain the tools for future success. Research shows students who take University 1 have a higher retention rate and are more successful in their university studies.

University Mentoring Program

The University Mentoring Program is a unique experience that offers first-year students the opportunity to interact one-on-one with a faculty or staff member outside the traditional classroom or office setting. Mentors provide guidance, friendship and support and serve as a role model for students. They share their educational experiences, and assist mentees with their academic and personal concerns.

In order to participate in the University Mentoring Program, you should be either a freshman, transfer, or reentry student and you are required to enroll in University 1.
